1. Roll Call

2. No Minutes Available

- 3. Bike Day at LACMA Update:** The event is scheduled for September 10 and 11. Approved by LACMA Board. They hope to have MCWCC be a co-sponsor

- 4. Trolley Update:** Several cities have similar projects; Working on the following issues:

- o Identify parking for trolley,
- o Cost not yet determined, and
- o How many cars to replace by Trolley not determined, yet.

- 5. BIKE PARKING PROPOSED ORDINANCE** (City Planning Commission postponed Hearing)
Discussion about requirement to provide bike parking (yes required new permits and changes); can reduce car requirements; reduction of parking is worse problem;

PROPOSED MOTION - the TPS committee supports the concept for the increase of bicycle parking but not the ordinance as proposed because of the potential loss of vehicular parking and the exclusion of government buildings.
