

MCWCC Transportation, Parking and Streetscape Committee
Meeting of 7/20/10
MINUTES

Meeting was called to order by Chair Tim Deegan at 7:05 p.m. at the MCWCC office, 543 N. Fairfax Ave., Los Angeles

Present: Barnett, Brazeman, Deegan, Edwards, Guzman, Jacobberger, Kuszynski, Weiner.

Absent: Feldman, Kremer, Tomaszewski

Minutes from the April 20 meeting were not available.

Secretary: no member has yet offered to be secretary of the committee.

Budget discussion with committee members and representatives from Budget Committee (Angela Guzman and Sharon Lake). Jeff Jacobberger will provide Budget Committee with breakdown of the \$5,000 requested for Kiosk maps.

Name change: the committee discussed changing the committee name to Transportation committee but does not want to make the change. The committee will continued to be called Transportation, Parking and Streetscape.

Ad hoc committee: The committee passed a unanimous motion to establish an ad hoc Bicycle Committee to follow the Los Angeles City Draft Bike Plan through adoption by the City, and to report back to the committee on developments. David Weiner was appointed to chair the committee.

Monitoring transportation projects: several committee members offered to monitor specific transportation modes and report to the committee on activity and progress. They are:

Metro Transit - Jeff Jacobberger

L.A. City Bike Plan (ad hoc Bicycle Committee) - David Weiner

Metro Wilshire Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Cary Brazeman

DASH Fairfax - Mark Edwards

Metro Subway to the Sea - Tim Deegan

Crescent Heights-Edinburgh-Colgate Median Landscaping Project: two community members, Maria Hernandez and Jeffrey Segal, presented an overview to the committee of what they described as a safety and beautification project at the median located at this intersection. After discussion with the committee Ms. Hernandez and Mr. Segal agreed to go to their neighbors and try to build consensus with them for the need to take neighborhood action. Ms.

Hernandez and Mr. Segal were encouraged by the committee to feel welcome to return to TPS for further discussion as their plan develops.

Public Comment: Joan Taylor spoke to the committee about the value of having the MCWCC learn more of the transportation needs of seniors that would be accomplished by having neighborhood senior centers visited by the MCWCC seniors representative. Ms. Taylor was referred to the MCWCC Administrator to arrange follow through with the appropriate MCWCC board member.
